ANCHOR LINE SELECTION PROCESS

- 1. Choose Rope Diameter
- 2. Choose Rope Length. Note typical minimum DBN splicing length = 6ft. Otherwise 3-Strand Nylon is used
- 3. Choose Rope Color / Combination

4. Our anchor lines come STD with a galvanized thimble splice on one end (or optional Lt duty stainless steel). The thimble can be further specified as heavy duty (stainless steel or galvanized). We assume the other end of the anchor line is bitter.

- 5. Choose an optional stainless steel or galvanized Bow Shackle, Anchor Shackle, or Anchor Swivel.
- 6. Choose optional anchor chain (proof coil or windlass grade (G4 HT or BBB) & in stainless steel or galvanized)
- 7. Repeat Selection Process for each Anchor Line
- 8. You may select a separate whipping twine color for each set of Anchor Lines, otherwise the splicer chooses a common color

Note: All lines are custom made-to-order and further customization can be specified for your application.

Double Braided Lines are whipped and sewn at the throat of the splice and at the bitter end.
